A crisis support line run by Aboriginal People, for Aboriginal People. 13 YARN is a free and confidential service that has Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander crisis support workers available to provide support 24/7.

Lifeline (13 11 14)

Provides all Australians experiencing emotional distress with access to 24-hour crisis support and suicide prevention services, so no person in Australia has to face their darkest moments alone.

Beyond Blue (1300 224 636)

One of Australia's most well-known, trusted, and visited mental health organisations, it provides a helping hand wherever you are on your mental health journey.
